Based in Independence Oregon, EAA chapter 292 is one of the premier EAA branch chapters with better than 220 members from all over the Willamette Valley. Our local chapter, along with the surrounding aviation community, come together to promote and support general aviation through events like fly-ins and aviation related socials, educational programs for youth and aviation safety and more. Our chapter members engage in aircraft building and restoration, and have a strong support for local youth related programs to help inspire and support the next generation.

Our youth programs include:

YOUNG EAGLES

Our Young Eagles Rally is held twice annually (June & September) to give young people, ages 8-18, an introduction to aviation principles with various hands-on activities, including a flight in a real airplane.

Young Eagles events are FREE but do require prior registration. Participants receive a Young Eagles certificate and an entry in their very own log book.



TEEN AVIATION WEEKEND

This FREE weekend workshop is tailored to teens (14 - 19 year olds) and offers opportunities to learn more about aerodynamics and aircraft construction.

Activities include:

- Exploring aviation history and airplane controls
- Building a model airplane
- Flying a simulator
- Plotting a course between airports
- Discussing aviation careers with industry professionals



TEEN BUILD PROJECTS

Youth ages 14 through high school can participate in our Teen Build Program which is on-going throughout the year.

Our technical experts mentor and supervise teens as they construct an actual kit plane. Teens learn how to read plans, fabricate parts, the proper use of tools, and how to register an experimental aircraft with the FAA.
